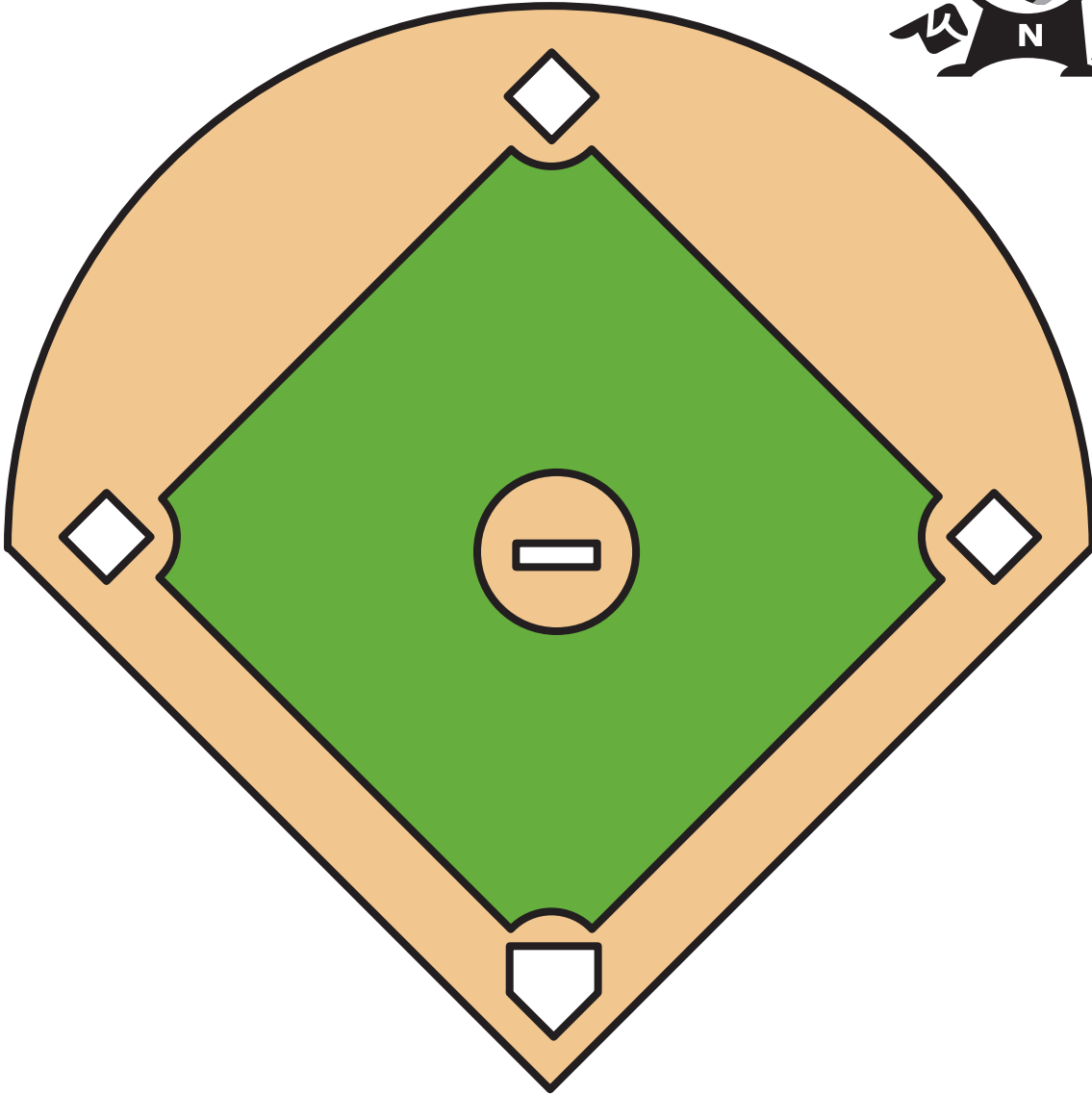

Answer: Add an apostrophe and an "s"

2. What do you add to witch to make it possessive?

Answer: Add an apostrophe "s", witch's.

3. Is this correct ... (write on board, overhead or sentence strip) ...
Does the princess's tiara need polishing?

Answer: It is correct.

4. What do you add to make a plural noun ending in "s" possessive?

Answer: Just add an apostrophe.

5. How do you make busses possessive?

Answer: Just add an apostrophe, busses'.

6. Is this correct ...(write on board, sentence strip or overhead)... When will
they finish remodeling the womens' bathroom?

Answer: It should be "the women's bathroom."

7. What do you add to make a plural noun not ending in "s" possessive?

Answer: Add an apostrophe and an "s".

8. What do you add to the name, Maximus, to make it possessive?

Answer: Add an apostrophe and an "s," Maximus's.

9. Is this correct (write on board, overhead or sentence strip): Where did I put
Henry's quarter that I owe him? **Answer:** It should be "Henry's quarter."

10. What do you add to everything to make it possessive?

Answer: Add an apostrophe and an "s," everything's.
