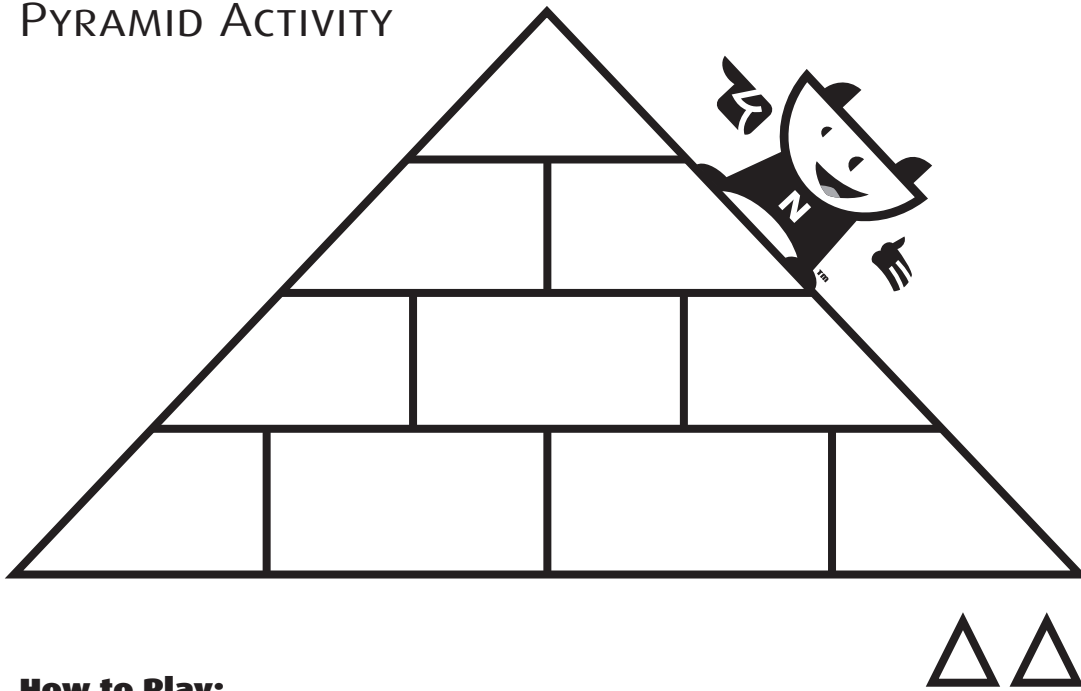

Plural Possessive Nouns

PYRAMID ACTIVITY

**How to Play:**

- 1.** Draw or have one of your students draw two pyramids (with dividing lines as shown above) on the board. The pyramids should be next to each other on the board.
- 2.** Next divide the class into two teams. Select a card holder from each team (Each team has a different color flashcard).
- 3.** The students line up single file (relay race style) facing the pyramid on the board and the card holder.
- 4.** The card holder faces the line of teammates, and when the game begins, the student looks at the index card the holder displays and rushes to the pyramid to make the noun plural. He/she may write in any block and then move to the end of the line.
- 5.** If there is an incorrect answer placed in the pyramid, the CARD HOLDER may correct it, but it counts as a turn (no one may be writing while he or she corrects).
- 6.** The first team who fills in the pyramid with the most correct plural noun forms (ten total) wins. You may add variations for difficulty. For instance, one person writes the plural, and the next in line writes the rule# next to it.
- 7.** Raffle tickets go to the winning team.
