Example: Kino heads out ~~at~~^{TO} sea to go diving.

1. Juana and Kino don't have any assets ~~beside~~^{BESIDES} their canoe.
2. As Juana and Kino head out, Kino wades ~~between~~^{AMONG} the seaweed and picks some to put on Coyotito's wound.
3. As Kino dives, one oyster differs ~~with~~^{FROM} the rest of the oysters.
4. A "ghostly gleam" was coming ~~off~~^{FROM} the oyster.
5. He was drawn ~~at~~^{TO} the oyster.
6. Finally, Kino cuts ~~in~~^{INTO} the oyster and discovers the largest pearl that they have ever seen.
7. ~~Beside~~^{BESIDES} its monetary value, Kino is shocked to discover that its presence causes Coyotito's wound to begin healing.
8. Kino and Juana beginning yelling, which brings all of the canoes over ~~besides~~^{BESIDE} their canoe.
9. All of the neighbors differ ~~from~~^{WITH} each other about what Kino should do with the money that the pearl will bring.
10. All of them hope that Kino will make a lot of money ~~off~~^{FROM} the sale of the huge pearl.
