Questions:

1. Name two of the five Indefinite Pronouns which can be used as either singular or plural.

A. *all, any, most, none, some*

2. If an Indefinite Pronoun ends in body, one, or thing, is it singular or plural?

A. *singular*

3. Name three of the five plural Indefinite Pronouns.

A. *both, few, many, others, several.*

4. In this sentence, choose the correct verb to agree with the Indefinite Pronoun: All of the students (enjoy, enjoys) the Grammar Active™ Dice Game.

A. *All of the students enjoy the Grammar Active™ Dice Game.*

5. Which is correct? Most of my family (think/thinks) that I am a kind person.

A. *thinks...because most is singular or plural depending on most of what. Family is singular.*

7. None of Hal's work (was, were) considered good enough to sell.

8. Both of them (cries, cry) whenever I mention the word "homework."
