

IDENTIFY THE VERBS

Place a squiggly line under the verb(s) or verb phrase(s). On the line next to the sentence, write the noun or pronoun which is performing the actions (the subject). This activity can be done with a partner. As soon as you finish, silently raise your left hand(s). If your answers are correct, you will receive raffle tickets!

Hint: *Be sure to identify with squiggly lines all of the verbs in the sentence.*
